#### **Young Carers**

**Are you a student with a significant caring role?** This project supports students 18 years and under who have a significant caring role to complete their secondary education.

What is a Young Carer? A young carer is someone who provides significant support for a parent, partner, child, relative or friend who has chronic illness, disability, alcohol or other substance dependence or who is frail aged.

**What can we do?** Support is based on the individual needs of the young person but may include some of the following examples:

- Respite—a short break from your caring responsibilities to spend time on school work or other school activities.
- Tuition support.
- Material resources such as school books or uniforms.
- Support to attend school activities.
- Referral to appropriate services.

#### What will happen if I call your service?

Young Carers or their advocates will complete a Young Carers Eligibility Assessment that will inform the scope of your caring role and help understand the challenges. We will discuss what support will assist and who may help you. Contact us whenever you need to. It is a <u>free and</u> confidential service.
